NUG is the successor to the NEC User Group initiative started in the year 1991.

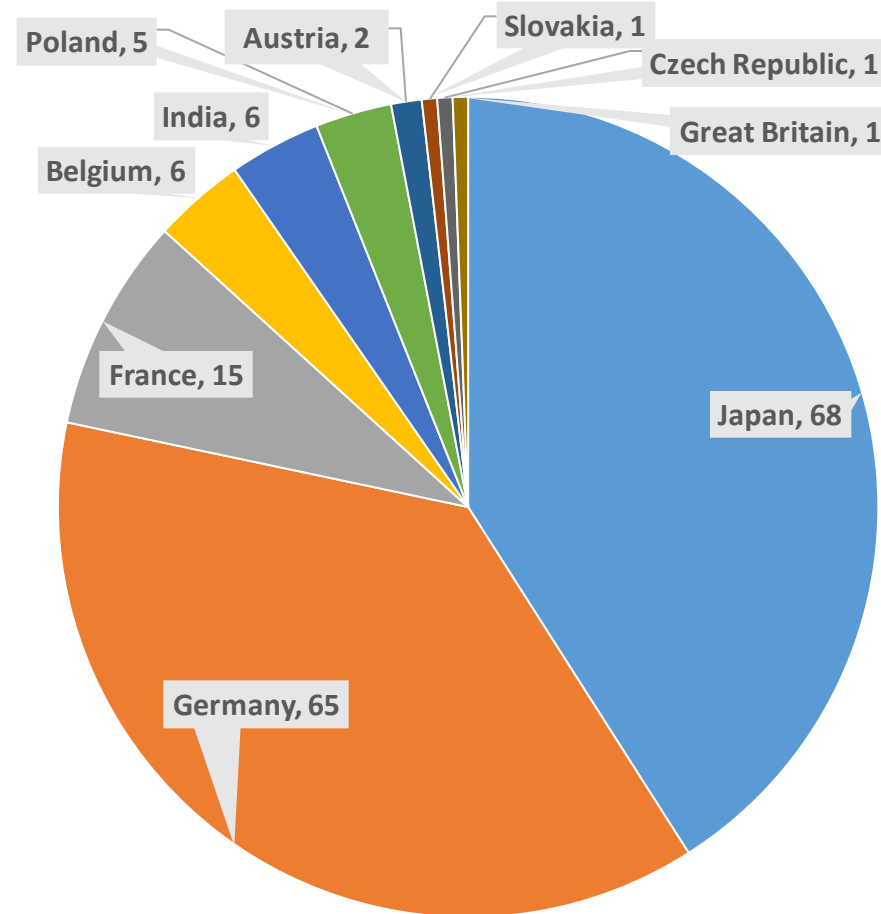
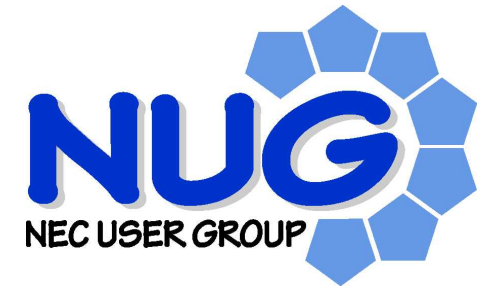
NUG is a Society according to Article 60 and following of the Swiss Civil Law (ZGB).
